#### OUR FAVOURITE ROUTES IN AND AROUND SEE:



##### VALLEY TRAIL FROM SEE TO GALTÜR

*Easy tour, distance: 29 kilometres, takes about two and a half hours*

There is a sign-posted trail through the Paznaun valley with several starting points for different tours. To get to know the area you could explore it on your way from **See** via **Kappl** and **Ischgl** to **Galtür**. If that's enough on your first day, you can always take the bus back.



##### MEDRIGALM

*Easy or intermediate tour, distance: 7 kilometres*

Depending on your level of fitness you can decide whether this tour is a walk in the park or a challenge. If you prefer to take it easy, get on the cable car that takes you up to the **Medrigalm** from where you can roll downhill back to the valley. The other option is to hit the pedals and conquer the 770 metres yourself.



##### SCHÖNVERWALL

*Very challenging tour, distance: 86 kilometres, takes about four and a half hours*

This route is one of the most beautiful tours in the **Silvretta Mountainbike Arena**, but not for the faint-hearted. The Schönverwall valley between **St. Anton** and the **Heilbronner Hütte** is very popular among mountain bikers who cross the Alps towards the south. However, the northern part is much more fun. Long gravel trails and rocky paths like the **Verwall trail** lead through the marvellous scenery to rustic huts and eventually back to **St. Anton** from where you can take a bus or taxi back to See.
